

LOCAL LAW NO. 8 OF THE YEAR 2008 – DELEGATING TO THE CHIEF OF POLICE THE POWER GRANTED TO THE MAYOR TO REQUEST AND GRANT POLICE ASSISTANCE.

Be it enacted by the Village Board of the Village of Alfred, Allegany County, New York as follows:

The purpose of this local law is to delegate to the Chief of Police the powers granted to the Mayor under Section 209-M of the General Municipal Law of New York State to request and grant police assistance.

SECTION ONE – Content

In accord with Section 209-M of the General Municipal Law of New York State there is delegated to the Chief of Police the powers granted to the Mayor under Article 10 Section 209-M of the General Municipal Law of New York State to request police assistance.

SECTION TWO - Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Department of State.
