

VILLAGE OF ALFRED, NEW YORK

LOCAL LAW NO. 2 - 1984

A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING THAT THE VILLAGE OF ALFRED SHALL CEASE TO BE AN ASSESSING UNIT AND THEREAFTER ALL VILLAGE TAXES SHALL BE LEVIED ON THAT PART OF THE TOWN ASSESSMENT ROLE ON PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE VILLAGE OF ALFRED, ALLEGANY COUNTY, NEW YORK.

Be it enacted by the Village Board of the Village of Alfred, Allegany County, New York as follows:

The Village of Alfred shall hereby cease to be an assessing unit and Village taxes shall thereafter be levied on that part of the town assessment role covering property within the Village of Alfred, Allegany County, New York and the Village shall cease to be an assessing unit and the provisions of Section 1402 of the Real Property Law of the State of New York and the Village of Alfred and all provisions of said Section 1402 of the Real Property Law of the State of New York for the making and reviewing of the assessment of real property within the Village of Alfred shall not apply to the said Village of Alfred, Allegany County, New York.
